Fitness Room Supplemental Use Rules

- In consideration to other users, please limit your workout to 30 minutes per session and be mindful of others waiting to use the facility.
- Please turn the air filtration unit on when beginning your workout and turn it off when finished. The switch is marked on top of the machine.
- Please use the provided disinfectant wipes to clean equipment both before and after use.
- Do not use the Fitness Room if you feel ill, have a persistent cough, have had a fever in the last 48 hours, are having difficulty breathing, have other flu-like symptoms, or have had a positive COVID-19 test within the past 14 days.
- Please notify us at <u>management@nationalparkseminary.org</u> if you exhibit COVID-19 symptoms within 48 hours of room use. Please include the date of use of the facility, when you began exhibiting symptoms, and whether you have tested positive for COVID in your email. All notifications will be kept strictly confidential.

Community Room Supplemental Use Rules
